The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) received and approved your application for a U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) registration number to operate in interstate commerce.

Please be aware that ALABAMA TRANSPORT SERVICES LLC is required to also apply for and be granted operating authority registration before conducting any transportation as a motor carrier in interstate commerce requiring operating authority registration. FMCSA will contact you to schedule the required New Entrant safety audit.

The New Entrant safety audit will verify, among other things, the following:

- Participation in a drug and alcohol testing program that includes random, pre-employment, and other required testing, and registration in FMCSA's Drug and Alcohol Clearinghouse (if employing drivers with Commercial Drivers' Licenses (CDL));
- Documentation of Periodic (annual) motor vehicle inspections;
- Proper use of Electronic Logging Devices and/or Records of Duty Status (as applicable) to document hours of service;
- Evidence of the required minimum level of financial responsibility (insurance) (if applicable);
- Use of drivers with proper CDL's (if applicable).

Notice of application was published in the FMCSA Register issue of March 31, 2026. If applicant fails to comply within 20 days from the date of publication in the FMCSA Register, a decision will be served notifying the applicant that the application will stand dismissed for want of prosecution unless applicant complies with the requirements within 60 days.

**Please note: A dismissal is the equivalent of a rejection and the only cure is either (1) an appeal, because you have evidence that insurance was actually filed, or (2) to file a new application.**
